

Big Shot—with the OLD platform with 2 tabs on hinges

SANDWICHES—shown in order

(1st line is the top; bottom line is the bottom of the sandwich)

I have NO pictures with this form. Just read carefully. Unless you have something called wafer thin dies, there is NO NEED to use the platform with both tabs closed (being used.)

For **DIES**:

- Clear cutting mat (newer ones are labeled #3)
- Die—cut side down on cardstock
- Clear cutting mat (#3)
- Thick Base/Platform with 1 hinged tab out of the way/opened up

For **STANDARD Embossing Folders**:

- Clear cutting mat (newer ones are labeled #3)
- Embossing folder with cardstock inside; send SEAM thru first!
- Clear cutting mat (#3)
- Thick Base/Platform with BOTH hinged tabs out of the way/opened up

For **3D Embossing Folders (with ONLY the Stampin' Up! name on it)**:

- Specialty Plate (labeled #4); you may *instead* have a clear blue-ish plate that was available while we still had the Big Shot
- 3D Embossing folder with cardstock inside; send SEAM thru first!
- Thick Base/Platform with BOTH hinged tabs out of the way/opened up

For **Older 3D Embossing Folders (with Stampin' Up! AND Sizzix names on it)**:

- Clear cutting mat (newer ones are labeled #3)—just 1 plate is used!
- Older 3D Embossing folder with cardstock inside; send SEAM thru first!
- Thick Base/Platform with BOTH hinged tabs out of the way/opened up
